

## Final grade

The proposed operator:

$$\text{final\_grade} = \max(\text{exam\_grade}, 0.8 * \text{exam\_grade} + 0.2 * \text{homework\_grade})$$

iff (average homework grade - exam) < 1

honors the ETH regulations as exercises are completely voluntary and it will fall back to the standard exam-only grade if you decide to spend all your energy there.

## Homework

Example: for the exercise 1 and a person with nethz login name: janedoe the file name would be: janedoe\_ex01.zip (.tar, .tar.gz are also OK)

## Homework grading information

You are responsible for your homework grade. You should use our provided exercise solutions as a benchmark to determine a grade for the exercises you have handed-in.

For grading, consider these steps:

- Use the relation  $3.0 + (6.0 - 3.0) * \text{points}/\text{maxpoints}$  for an indication of where your grade should approximately be placed
- Use the points assigned to each exercise solutions to determine your point ratio  $\text{points}/\text{maxpoints}$
- Adhere to the code of honor

We will collect your grades at the end of the course. For submitting the HW grades, consider these steps:

- Generate a table for your grading with the following layout:

- Use two columns with the exercise ID in the first column and your grade in the second column. Optionally, you may provide a third column with comments that defend your concluding grade.
- Leave the table cell blank for exercises that have not been submitted
- Name the table file with your legi-number, i.e., xx-xxx-xxx.txt (where the x's correspond to the legi-ID)
- The table should be stored in a simple text file (ASCII characters) (not rich text or anything similar).
